### **Where are we today ?**

We have exceeded the fundraising target that was needed in the feasibility study stage of the project budget. ### **What is happening now ?**

BBI Canada, who attended the original launch and fundraising drive, has been contracted to complete the feasibility study. They will be in the Battlefords in mid June for site analysis work and evaluation. The study will be prepared by August 2007 and results known shortly thereafter.

### **What happens after the feasibility study ?**

In August 2007, once the feasibility study is completed, results and study will be reviewed and copies made available after the harvest season. After a comprehensive review of the study, we will complete a business plan and environmental assessments. Funds to complete the Business Plan and Environmental Assessment have already been raised.

### **Will the project need local investment ?**

Continued support will be needed, and investment opportunities will be made public once all due diligence is completed. At this time the structure for investment or price tag has not been determined.

### **How is the money that has been collected being spent ?**

The Battlefords Chamber of Commerce continues to manage the money that has been collected and administers required disbursements
